Format

- Before the session we will scale estate agents drawings 1:100 for initial sketches and plan options so that you can begin to visual the space and how it will be used.

- We will explain the planning process and share examples of recent applications that have been approved and/or rejected in the vicinity.

Fees

There is a one-off reduced fee of £300 for the consultation and take-away information (normally £400). If you decide to move forward with Collective Works this amount will be deducted from the first concept phase of the overall project.





Preparation



Before the consultation, to inform our suggestions, we will ask you to have a think about your budget and how you will use the space. It is not compulsory at this stage to have exact numbers as during the session we will explore the range of options and budgets. We will also provide a list of anything else that you need to bring such as estate agent drawings and any photographs you might already have.
